Should I call "Clear" at Intersections?

I have been sitting on the fence for years about calling "clear" at intersections. On the positive side, calling clear falls into the same category as calling out potholes, glass, or any obstructions – it's a courtesy to following riders. However, I have been vexed by the possibility that I miss something at an intersection and a following rider is lulled into a false security, doesn't check for themselves, and a collision occurs. Calling clear does not absolve following riders from following the law. In intersections where a yield is called for, that is one thing. But where the intersection has a stop sign, has more complexities, with limited sightlines, well that's a different breed of cat altogether. We need every member to assess intersections for themselves and follow applicable laws. Legally, I think that I would prefer to banish the practice from a liability standpoint. Doing so would likely release the club and club members of any wrongdoing . . . maybe. I guess I'm still on the fence. CLEAR!
