July 29 - August 1, 2022

Depart Edmonton 07:00 Friday July 29; return about 18:00 Monday Aug 1.

EBTC is pleased to offer this challenging ride again. The photo is from 2018. This ride is one of the toughest in Alberta - 312 km and two passes: 1390m up to the Icefields (11km at 8%); 800m up to the Bow Summit over 36 km.



This ride is for strong intermediate to advanced riders able to sustain more than 24 KPH on flat terrain and to manage long climbs. Given the challenge providing support, riders must be able to stay with the main group and cannot be picked up and driven up hills. Therefore, members participating in this ride will have completed Enduro 160, Stamina Builder Ardrossan 100, or Ultime series rides or be known by Ride Coordinators to be able to successfully complete this tour. All cyclists must be prepared to ride in cold, rainy or even snowy conditions. This is Alberta after all.

Bus transportation + truck & trailer (for bikes wrapped in blankets) will be provided to Jasper and from Canmore, with shuttles among mountain locations.

Accommodation will be at the HI Jasper and HI Lake Louise (showers available). The forecasted cost for 26 riders is ~ \$600 + 3 dinners (location your choice).
