#### EBTC Social Event Coordinator: Board Position

EBTC has several social events throughout the year. Annually we have the AGM, Volunteer Appreciation, and Spring Social, in addition to events associated with rides like the Pigeon Lake Picnic.

As Volunteer Social Coordinator your role would be working with other Board Members and volunteers to organize and stage club events. This would involve:

- Selection of a date and location for the event, with input from other Board Members
- Arranging for food and refreshments and any other items needed for the event
- Preparation of and presentation of the event budget to the Board or Finance Committee for approval
- Documentation and provision of all receipts for expenditures to the Treasurer for reimbursement or filing as required.
- Attends EBTC Board Meetings

#### Equipment Manager: Special Volunteer and non-Board Position

EBTC has over the years accumulated a small amount of equipment which is held in storage. This equipment includes items such as a barbeque, Coleman stoves, cooking utensils, water carboys and coolers. Ownership of these items by EBTC makes it easy and convenient for the social coordinator and ride leaders of overnight trips and special events. The role of the Equipment Manager is to:

- Be the Equipment Boss for EBTC!
- · Have an updated inventory of items available
- Help ride leaders and other authorized members access the equipment in storage for their event
- Ensure the items are returned clean and in good condition to storage
- Report items needing repair or replacement to the EBTC Board

Attendance at EBTC Board meetings is not required. However, materials will be made available.

The Ride Support Coordinator must be knowledgeable about safe group riding, aware of club riding policies and understand the club cycling scale, able to plan routes with RWGPS, comfortable with Karelo and willing to attend some club rides to check in, especially when there is new Ride Leader. No board meeting attendance required and know that we can help you get up to speed with RWGPS and Karelo.
