

Drumheller 2025 – Dinos with Drama

Ride Description: Hub and Spoke

Itinerary:

Day 1 Fri. May 23 – **36km** Horseshoe Canyon and back

(individual self guided option to Rosebud loop ride 70km)

Day 2 Sat. May 24 – **46 km** Hoodoos and Wayne Last Chance Saloon for lunch.

(individual self guided option to East Coulee before lunch)

5:30-10:15pm Rosebud Theatre "The Foreigner" (optional)

Day 3 Sun. May 25 – **50 km** Dino Trail Route, 400m elevation gain over two climbs

Day 4 Mon May 26 – **46km** Hoodoos and Wayne Last Chance Saloon for lunch

Daily out and back rides with group-up points along the route. This is a no-drop ride, but there will be **no sag wagon available**. Meet up points include some scenic locations.

Rides planned are in the 36 to 70 km range with total elevation gains of up to 400m. If the conditions (weather, smoke) are not suitable for cycling, Drumheller is home to the Tyrrell Museum and boasts many other tourist attractions nearby.

Accommodations and Food: These are the responsibility of cyclists and are to be reserved/booked and paid by participants (Hotels, camp site, B&B, snacks and meals). A group dinner will be planned for Friday night and a group lunch at Wayne for Saturday and Monday.

Rosebud Theatre: Saturday, May 24 evening performance (&buffet)

Participants have the option of purchasing tickets for the last performance of "The Foreigner" at the Rosebud Dinner Theatre. Dinner starts between 5:30 and 6:30 and is served until 7:30pm. The show starts at 8 pm and runs until about 10:15. The theatre is about 28km (30-minute drive) from Drumheller. Tickets are \$96 per person including a buffet supper. Tickets without the buffet are \$64 per person. Tickets are non-refundable.
