- 68 out of the 219 registered riders identified as EBTC members.
- EBTC members filled 16 out of 45 volunteer positions.
- EBTC members provided 11 of the 13 Marshals on the three routes.

Char expressed appreciation to our EBTC volunteers with special thanks to **Danielle Amerongen** and **Anne Marie Adachi** who were involved from the very beginning in developing the concept of the ride, determining the gorgeous routes matching the Stamina Builder Series and the natural beauty of our biosphere. They were there for encouragement, registration, set up, take down - and also served our riders as Marshals. "They were simply incredible!"

"Big thanks to all of our Marshals who took care of our riders, kindly and professionally.
