EBTC is looking for a 'Special Volunteer' with an interest in communications. Stop as Yield Laws

Alright, we all do it. Yes, that's right - vehicle drivers, cyclists, skateboarders - we all do it. What am I on about? Rolling through stop signs. If you fail to stop at a stop sign in Alberta, you can be fined \$405.00! But what is the evidence that stop signs result in safer intersections for cyclists?

In many jurisdictions outside of North America stop signs are the exception, replaced by Yield\Give Way signs. Many would agree with me when I say that Alberta is not the most progressive jurisdiction when it comes to cycling – just look at the difficulty in getting legislation to require motor vehicle drivers to allow 1 metre of distance when passing cyclists.
