




Drumheller Trip, May 25 to 28, 2023

Day 1: Thirteen of the group arrived in time for a ride on Friday to Horseshoe Canyon and beyond. Most went to Rosebud – 73 km return with 590 m of climbing. The temperature was ideal, no smoke smell at all and not much wind. Great riding through rolling terrain.







Day 2: We rode the Dinosaur Trail loop, north on the east side of the river, across on the Bleriot Ferry and south back to town on the west side. 52 km with two good climbs in 400m of total climb. Sunny with just a few clouds, temperatures from midteens at the start to mid-20s with a good breeze to keep us cool the last few kilometres (and prevent us exceeding the speed limit).







Day 3: We visited the famous hoodoos and the equally renowned Last Chance Saloon in Wayne. A great recovery ride of 47 km with 180 m of climbing; a little warmer, up to 28C by the end but cooler most of the day, with constant sun and little breeze. Roads around here a mostly great with little traffic even on the weekend this early in the season.





From the Saddle


