Staff at MEC are available to run 1/2 hour sessions on:

- Putting your bike away for the winter which includes what to do to ensure it is ready to go next spring, with essential products to clean parts.
- Winter Riding what kind of bike can be used, appropriate tires, clothing, and protective gear are required for safe and enjoyable riding in those colder temperatures.
- What if I want to think about an e-bike? What is available from MEC and what does a new e-bike rider need to know about sizes, and power needed.
- Lastly, if staff are willing, a session on hiking/cross country skiing products available. New technology coming in this fall.

When you attend the sessions, do not be afraid to ask questions as they are meant to be interactive and inclusive of all skill levels. Make sure you walk away with something important to you. The staff are fantastic and knowledgeable. Closer to the date, the times, and locations will be announced as MEC identifies areas in the store at which the sessions will take place. 
